#### **FOCUS AREA AND ACHIEVEMENTS**

Education & Sponsorship: Provided school supplies (books, uniforms, shoes, etc.) to 6 pupils at Mulenga Primary School (Kitwe) & Gilgal Orphanage (Solwezi).

Menstrual Health & Reproductive Education: Conducted outreach at 3 orphanages in Lusaka, educating 105 girls and providing reusable sanitary products.

Mentorship Programs: Covered career development, leadership, health, and drug abuse awareness in schools.

Climate Change Awareness: Partnered with All for One Initiative Zambia to reach 5,000 pupils through climate education. Planted 600 trees in Mansa schools and communities.

Impact: Empowered young people and contributed to sustainable community development


### SPONSORSHIP AND PERSONNAL DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM



In January 2024, Scholars of Hope Foundation revamped its child sponsorship project to support children from low-income backgrounds by providing essential school supplies, including books, uniforms, shoes, and stationery. The first cohort sponsored six pupils from Kitwe and Solwezi, offering both material support and mentorship sessions, including skill development programs at the American Corner, to foster their personal and academic growth.

# MENSTRUAL HYGIENE/SRH EDUCATION AND REUSABLE PADS DISTRIBUTION

In early 2024, Scholars of Hope Foundation, Genhope Foundation, and Project Zambia collaborated to educate and support 150 orphaned girls on menstrual health. Covering topics like puberty, hygiene, and reusable pad use, the initiative reached three orphanages in Lusaka equipping girls with essential knowledge and resources for sustainable menstrual management.





# CLIMATE CHANGE AWARENESS AND TREE PLANTING PROGRAMS



In partnership with All for One Initiative Zambia, Scholars of Hope Foundation implemented climate change awareness programs across 20 schools and communities in Mansa. Beyond education, the initiative promoted sustainability by planting 600 trees, long-term environmental fostering impact.



# MENTORSHIP AND CAPACITY BUILDING PROGRAMS

As part of our mission to empower children and youths, the organization conducted a of series mentorship programs in schools, focusing leadership, career on development, health, and drug abuse awareness. These sessions aimed to equip students with essential life skills, inspire personal growth, and promote informed decision-making for healthier and more successful future.







# WINTER & FESTIVE OUTREACH PROGRAMS

On January 1 and June 8, 2024, Scholars of Hope Foundation, in partnership with the Copperbelt University Society, visited Sera Rose Children's Home to provide mentorship, support, and donations. The visit included sessions on leadership, hygiene, teenage pregnancy, and drug abuse, along with interactive games like football to promote teamwork. Essential groceries were also donated, reinforcing the organizations' commitment uplifting vulnerable children through compassion and solidarity.




